


Battery Maintenance – Conventional Charging

LIQUID LEVEL DIAGRAM

- 1. Keep FLAMES, SPARKS, and METALLIC OBJECTS away from top of battery.
- 2. Only add APPROVED water AFTER battery has been FULLY CHARGED.
- 3. Read instructions on PROPER charger setting.
- 4. Allow battery to charge FULLY before using.
- Use hydrometer to check state of charge. 5.
- Keep battery top area clean and dry.
- 7. Allow battery to COOL down before using after charging.
- Keep charging equipment in good repair; clean occasionally by blowing out with compressed air.
- 9. Give COLD batteries EXTRA time to charge.
- 10. Wash and neutralize batteries when required.

DON'T

- 1. Don't overdischarge batteries.
- 2. DON'T add TOO MUCH water.
- 3. Don't change batteries UNNECESSARILY.
- 4. DON'T DISCONNECT battery before turning charger OFF.
- 5. Don't damage connectors by dropping on floor.
- DON'T lift batteries with NON-APPROVED lifting device.
- 7. Don't MEDDLE with charger adjustments.
- 8. Don't add anything other than APPROVED WATER to a battery.
- 9. Don't IGNORE problems. Eliminate them with proper action.
- 10. Don't GUESS about batteries and chargers. ASK questions – be informed, be safe and productive.
